- 2. Reports:
  - a. **Approve April Board Minutes:** The minutes were approved by SteveB with a second by CaroleK and approved by those present.
  - b. Treasurer's Report:
    - Club Financials: CaroleK Treasurer presented the STOC Operating report as of April 30, 2024.
